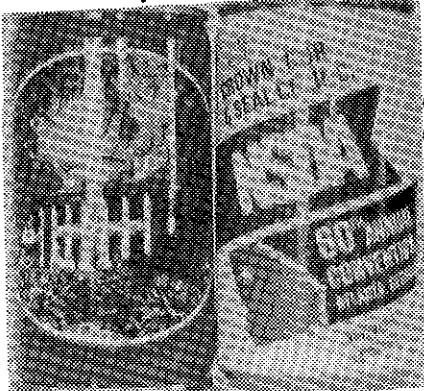
N.S.D.A.

Going free

Responding to America's increasing concern about caffeine — not to mention competition from RC and 7-Up — Pepsi has now tossed their effort into the ring. And, once again, Rochester is guinea pig for a new product. By the end of this week, you'll be able to buy Pepsi Free in all the usual places you find Pepsi, and it should be prominently displayed, according to Norman Sylvester, vice president of advertising for Pepsi. Actually, there are two new products — Pepsi Free has a sugarless companion. Sylvester, in town last week to show the new products around, noted that the company has been working on this project for two years. He said their research indicates that 90 percent of cola drinkers are aware that their favorite beverage contains caffeine, and two-thirds were interested in switching to a non-caffeine product, if they didn't have to sacrifice taste. But, unlike decaffeinated coffee, Sylvester says nothing is removed from caffeine-free colas; as a matter of fact, caffeine is added to regular colas, as well as many other soft drinks. But you're wondering what it does taste like. Well, cola drinkers we know tried it, and thought the regular tasted like Pepsi, the sugar free like Diet Pepsi. It will be priced comparably to other soft drinks, and there will be free sampling in area supermarkets, and lots of coupons and ads to get it kicked off right.

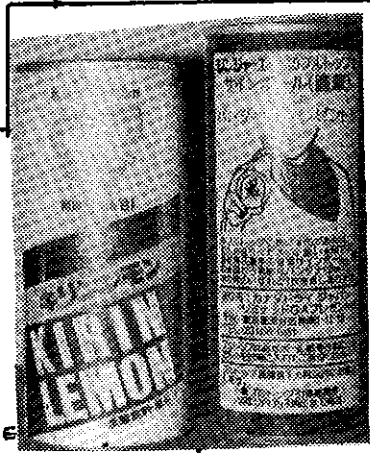

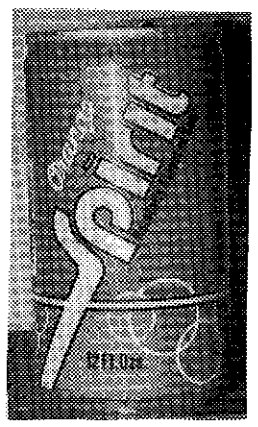

WOULDN'T IT BE GREAT.

. . . IF THERE WAS A LISTING, like stamp collecting, of all the pop cans that had ever been made.

While we'll probably never have the complete list, we do have a start. The Can World Pop Can Master File is computerized and contains over 10,000 different cans, all cataloged, referenced and described. In fact it is already over 250 pages long and growing.

If, as a dedicated pop can collector, you want to strengthen the hobby, here is a chance. Your help is needed to make the list of pop cans more complete.

Here's the plan. We'll start working on all of the brand names beginning with "A". If you will send us a note saying "Yes, I think I will help", we'll send you a packet of information consisting of the following:

1. A listing of all of the pop cans on the file whose brand names begin with "A".
2. A reference page showing how to use the listing.
3. Several "Master File Addition" sheets where you list new brands, canners, and generations.
4. An instruction sheet telling how to make additions to the file from cans in your collection.

After the changes you send have been added to the file, you will be sent an updated copy of the old listing plus the next alphabetical listing to work on. By the time we get to "Z", you will have a listing of all known pop cans.

A lot of detail work is involved in this project for all those who participate, but the rewards are more in-depth knowledge about a great hobby. Please help!

SPECIAL FREE OFFER:

Some pop can collectors specialize in certain flavors. The capability is now available with the Can World Master File to print "Flavor Lists" of all known cans of a certain flavor. A complete list of any flavor you desire is available FREE to anyone renewing a subscription, or getting a new member for NPCC. With your renewal or new member application, just note the flavor list you need.

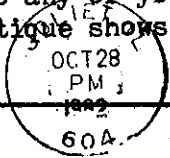
