If dad can, so can

Coralee . . . Can collecting now a family hobby

WHEN Coralee Wright, aged seven, announced she was going to collect soft drink cans, her parents weren't really surprised.

Her father, Bob, is a foundation member of the Australasian Beer Can Collectors' Association.

Children are easily distracted from ideas like this, but Coralee has stuck to her guns. After two years her 1000 cans are competing with beer cans for space in the garage-cum-display room under their Everton Hills home.

Although she probably was the first in Queensland to collect soft drink cans, Bob says it was her own idea.

And she has the added distinction of being the only female overseas member of the National Pop Can Collectors of the United States.

Can collecting is a highlight of the Wright family holidays.

"We've been as far west as Mitchell in Queensland and to the back blocks of New South Wales," Bob said.

"We look under any old building that's high up off the ground, but particularly country dance halls.

"Produce stores are a good source. Farmers come into town to stock up, have a few cans and then throw the empties under the building."

Coralee and Bob both trade Australian cans with collectors in other countries and have unusual cans from all over the world.

Bob said the postage, about \$30

a month, was their biggest expense.

Coralee's Coke cans look much the same as those you'd buy at the corner shop — until you see the Greek, Italian and Japanese labels.

And American diet sodas differ from ours in more than the names and flavors (Faygo; cherry with strawberry).

They carry the warning on the front that the chemicals contained "cause cancer in laboratory animals."

Bob said both collections were becoming excellent museums.

"You can trace some very unlikely events in can labels.

"In the picture on the front of last year's Foureux cans, the brewery had two chimneys and a diesel train in front.

"Since January 1, there are three chimneys and an electric train."

Space is at a premium in the Wright household as cans already line the walls and ceiling of the display room. Many of the new American arrivals are not up yet.

The family car may soon be banished to the street.

In case anyone wondered, all Bob's 1700 beer cans are empty . . . they have been punctured at the bottom so they appear full on the shelf.

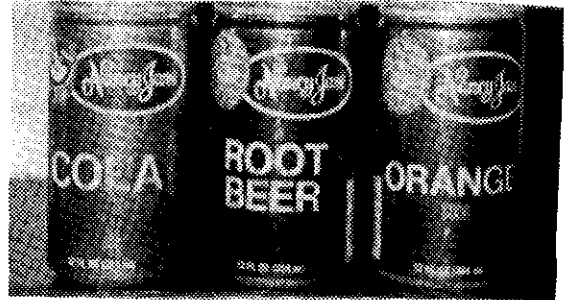
