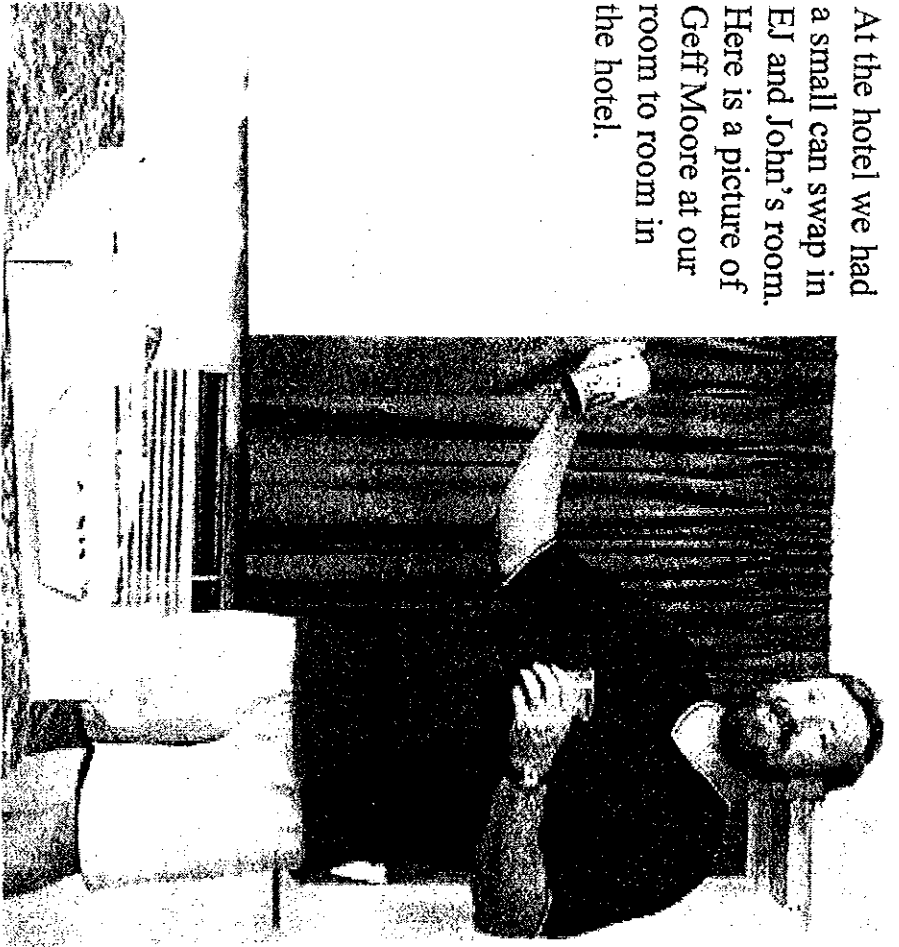

The morning of the show we all met in the lobby for continental breakfast and then headed out to the flea markets. I bought a couple of cans for my brother n law but the pickings were slim.

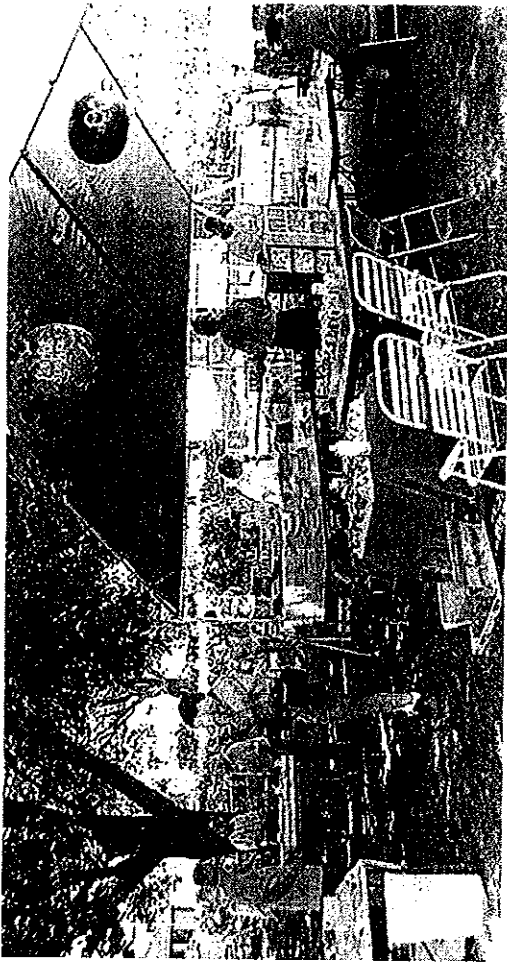
Got to the show a little early and we all got our cans and set up. Pretty much all day long there were collectors in and out of the show. Lots of trading and visiting went on for many hours.

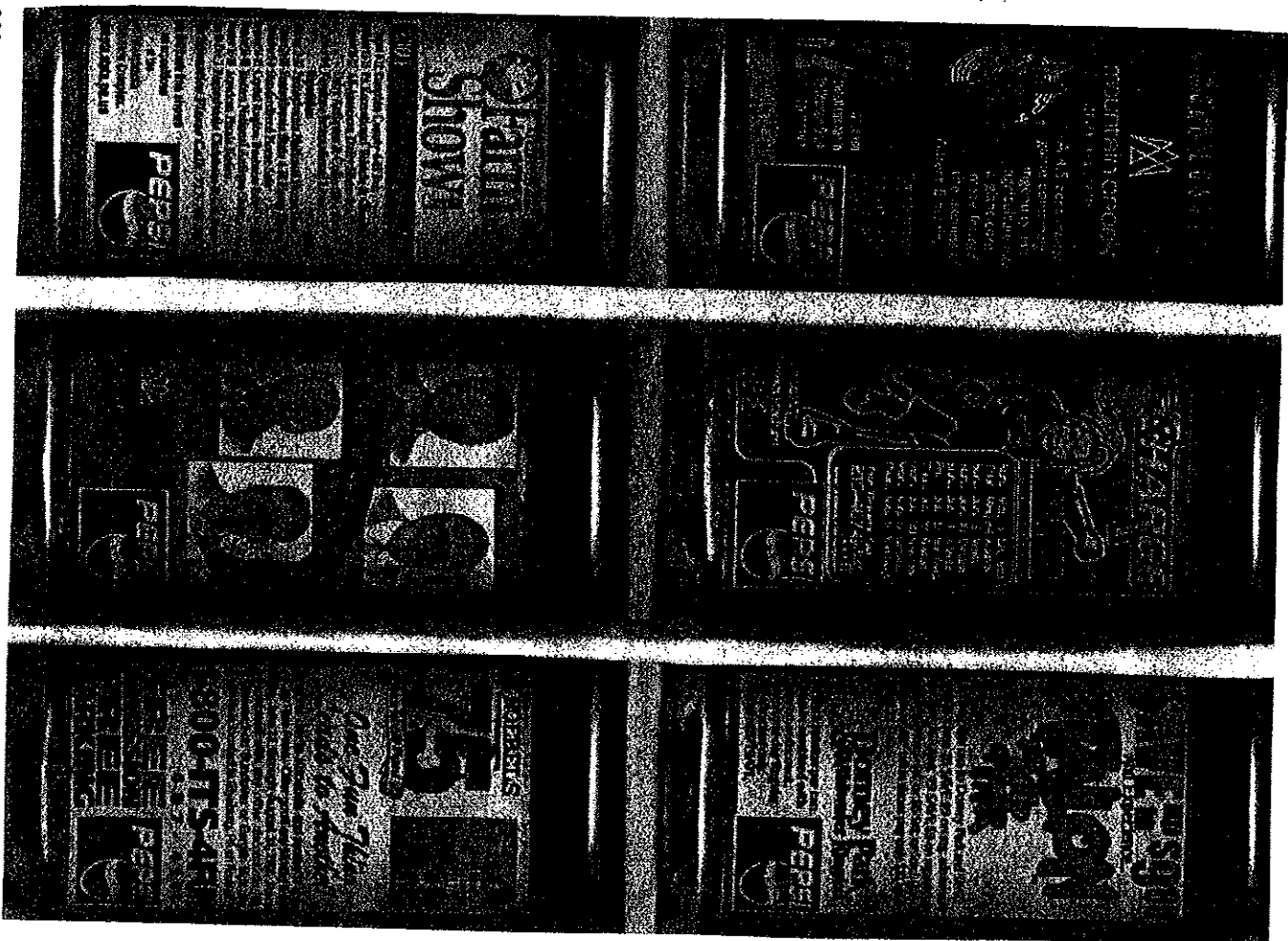
