Our policy is not to favor one collector group or another but to interact with as many groups as possible to bring awareness to our hobby and organization. 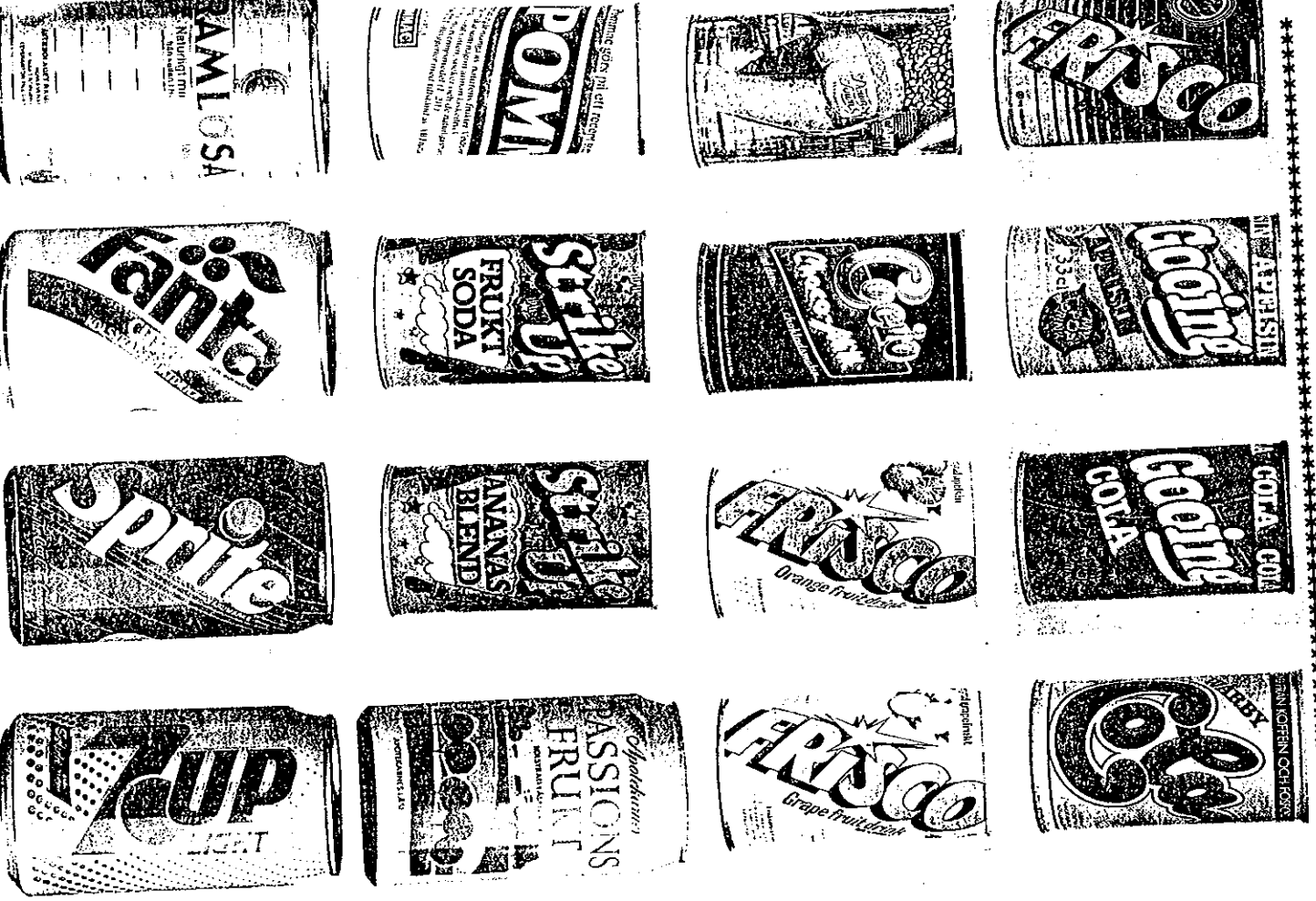

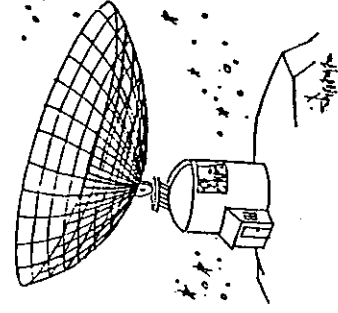
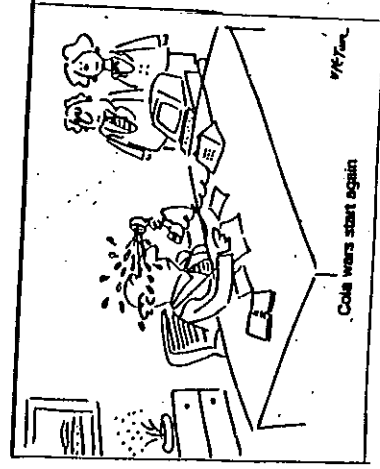
